

Entering MA01 Barrel Races

- **You** may call the District Director until 9 PM the night before the run and enter via phone & arrange to make a payment by check or cash at the show 508-896-4624.

Or:

- Email your entries to marineraussies@comcast.net. by 9PM the night before, and the director will reply to each entry made by email-
- No entries via Facebook will be accepted.
- The first draw will be done online the night before the run and can be viewed via watchmedad.com. The first draw for early entries will be posted at the entry booth and also on the watchmedad.com site. We will be taking entries only.
- If you enter the night before, you do not have to make out another entry form the day of the show. Just come up and pay for your entries.

Warm Ups may only be signed up for the day of the show.-First come first served.

You may also sign up on the day of the show-

- Use the theory that the sign ups will start at least 2 hours before the open begins. Please plan to pay in cash, since we are working to simplify paperwork, and are making pay outs in cash. We will accept checks but would rather not.
- Please sign up early. The order of go is usually posted ½ hour before the Open starts. If you sign up after that, you will be put at the bottom of the go. Those that sign up the day of the show will be put into a second draw.

The draws will be posted ring side/ and at the entry booth.

IF there is an unforeseen major weather change the day of the show, your payment will be carried over to the next race as a credit.

If you pre-enter for a run, and you do not show up to race, you are responsible to pay for your entries regardless.

TIME BLOCKS-

1. **Time Blocks** may only be signed up for the day of the show usually starting at 10:30-First come first served.

- Time Blocks usually start 2 hours before the Open Run. Each time block holds 10 riders per block. Each time block is designated by Number and Time. i.e.: Time Block 1 is from 11:00 to 11:15, Time Block 2 is from 11:15 to 11:30, Time

Block 3 is from 11:30 to 11:45 -Time Block 4 is from 11:45 to 12:00. Time Block 5 is from 12:00 -12:15, Time Block 6 is from 12:15-12:30-

- Open Arena is from 12:30 to 12:45-
- Ring is dragged.(12:45 to 12:00)
- We make every effort to accommodate those that want to ride in the time blocks. **BUT**-you also have to make the effort to sign up in time and to be ready to make your time block. **It is your responsibility to not be late or miss your block time. If you are late for your time block you will not be allowed to stay longer and run over into another block. If there is an opening in other blocks, you must pay an additional fee to ride.**
- If you miss your time block, or all the time blocks are filled, there will be an open arena (for 15 minutes) schooling barrels during open arena will not be allowed
- IF all the time blocks are filled and there are more riders wanting to have a warm up, we will add a block. However, if any of the time blocks have not filled, we will not add another block.
- The Little Wrangler starts at 12 Noon, Novice after that.
- The ring is then dragged, and Open will start.
- If this is an evening show, again, consider the time blocks to begin two hours before the Open starts or whenever Little Wrangler/Novice ends.

Day of Show-

Please, only the horses in each go are allowed to hang in the warm up pen located outside of the chute.

Results

1. Results of each Show will be posted on the MA01 website: nbhama01.com and will be posted on watchmedad.com under our barrel race dates.

- Points will be posted on our website, and also at each show.

2. **Show Cancellations**-Every effort is made to list all current members' phone numbers on the Calling Post. If there is to be a show cancellation due to weather, the calling post is generated to all members the night before the run-or if a close call, early, early morning. (your district director usually travels at least 1.5 hours to each run thus the early AM call)

We make every effort to have a smooth running show but please understand that at times situations arise that may throw a monkey wrench into the mix. We will make every attempt to keep the show running and would appreciate every ones co operation. If someone has an issue with regards to the show or facility we are at , please

direct your questions and concerns to the show management not the facility owner. We would also ask that everyone please pick up after themselves and their horses before leaving a facility and be respectful of each facility you run at.
